

## National Ilan University Admission Information for International Students for the Spring Semester 2022

## Reply Acceptance, Fill up Enrollment Registration Form

- 1. All admitted students MUST reply "Acceptance confirmation" on system before deadline. Please Log in NIU International Students Admissions Application System <a href="http://120.101.0.40/incoming/incoming.student/login/webSN/25">http://120.101.0.40/incoming/incoming.student/login/webSN/25</a>, click on "Confirmation of Registration" page to reply your acceptance confirmation. Deadline for replying acceptance confirmation: <a href="December 24">December 24</a>, 2021. Students who do not reply before the deadline will give up their positions. If scholarship recipients fail to reply acceptance confirmation by the deadline, they will forfeit their right to retain their financial aid awards.
- 2. Students MUST complete and upload the attached "Enrollment Registration Form"

  (Attachment 1 ERF) to Office of International Affairs by December 24, 2021 through the following linkage: https://forms.gle/Azhdn9sJYKfucg2Z7

## Registration

- 1. The semester will start on **February 21, 2022.** Students are advised to arrive the school during 14<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> of February to get familiar with the campus (Registration Procedures for International Students <a href="http://isa.niu.edu.tw/article/detail/webSN/30/sn/47/back/1">http://isa.niu.edu.tw/article/detail/webSN/30/sn/47/back/1</a>).
- 2. **ALL** new admitted students are required to register with the <u>Registration Office</u>, <u>Division of Academic Affairs by February 21, 2022</u>, with the following documents:
  - (1) **Photo**: For student ID card (2-inch, must be taken within the last 6 months)
  - (2) Original copy of highest diploma and English transcript of graduated school/college/university (with official stamp/seal verified by the Taiwan embassy, consulate or representative office near them in their country) (Attachment 3).
- 3. If an international student arrives NIU after February 21, 2022, he/she may not enroll for study in this semester. However, he/she may apply for registration in the following semester with the approval of the Office of International Affairs.

## Airport Pick-Up

Due to the global outbreak of novel coronavirus (COVID-19), the dates for NIU Airport Pick-up Service are still to be confirmed. We will further email you as long as <u>Taiwan Centers for</u>

Disease Control releases entry permit (by residence).

**Alien Resident Certificate** 

International students should apply Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) with 15 days counted from

the next day of arriving Taiwan. Application documents include:

(1) Photo

(white background, 4.5cm\*3.5cm with an image of the head that should not be shorter than

3.2 cm or longer than 3.6 cm from the top of the head to the chin. Without wearing a hat

or a pair of colored glasses, with clear facial features not covered and identifiable, and

should not be modified or composed).

(2) Student ID Card or Proof of Enrollment certificate (along with one copy) and Receipt of

Tuition Payment.

(3) Passport and resident visa

(4) Operation Fee (one year term): NT\$1,000

**Insurance** 

1. When you register at NIU, you should have your own health insurance for the first six months

prior to your enrollment in the National Health Insurance program. Overseas insurance should

be certified by the Taiwan government representative office of your country of origin or nearest

office.

2. International students who hold an Alien Resident Certificate for over six months are eligible

and required to join the National Health Insurance (NHI) program in Taiwan. All admitted

students should complete and mail the attached "Insurance Declaration" (Attachment 2) to

Office of International Affairs by deadline: December 24, 2021.

3. Note that this admission notice DOES NOT guarantee VISA issuance. Your VISA MUST only

be approved by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Taiwan, R.O.C. without exception (Please refer
